**NOTICE OF CHARITABLE BEQUESTS.**

THOMAS DELAMERE ROONEY (otherwise Thomas Rooney), Deceased.  
Notice is hereby given that Thomas Delamere Rooney (otherwise Thomas Rooney), late of 44 Upper O'Connell street, in the City of Dublin, Merchant's Clerk, by his Will dated the 3rd day of June, 1924, inter alia made the following bequests:-  
For the charitable purposes of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, Aughrim street branch, the sum of One Hundred Pounds... £100  
To the Little Sisters of the Poor, St. Patrick's House, Kilmallock, Dublin, to be applied by them in their charitable works, the sum of One Hundred Pounds... £100  
To Father Jones, C.O., of Aughrim street, Dublin, for Masses to be said in public in Ireland, for the Repose of the Testator's Soul and the Souls of his Relatives, the sum of Ten Pounds..... £10  
To the Superiors from the time being of St. Mary Magdalen Asylum, Lower Gloucester street, Dublin, the sum of One Hundred Pounds, to be applied towards the charitable purposes of the Institution..... £10  
To the St. Vincent de Paul Free Night Shelter for Catholic Men, Buck lane, Dublin, the sum of One Hundred Pounds, to be applied for the charitable purposes of the Institution..... £100  
And, after other bequests, the Testator bequeathed the residue of his property for such charitable purposes as his Executors might select. And the said Testator appointed Patrick Joseph Corcoran, of Athy, in the County of Kildare, Auctioneer, and Patrick Treacy, of Rooske, Maynooth, in the County of Kildare, Farmer, to be the Executors of his said Will. The said Testator, Thomas Delamere Rooney (otherwise Thomas Rooney) died on the 4th day of November, 1926, and his said Will was proved by the said Patrick Joseph Corcoran and Patrick Treacy, and Probate thereto granted to them forth of the Principal Probate Registry of the High Court of Justice, Baile Átha Cliath, on the 21st day of February, 1928.
