

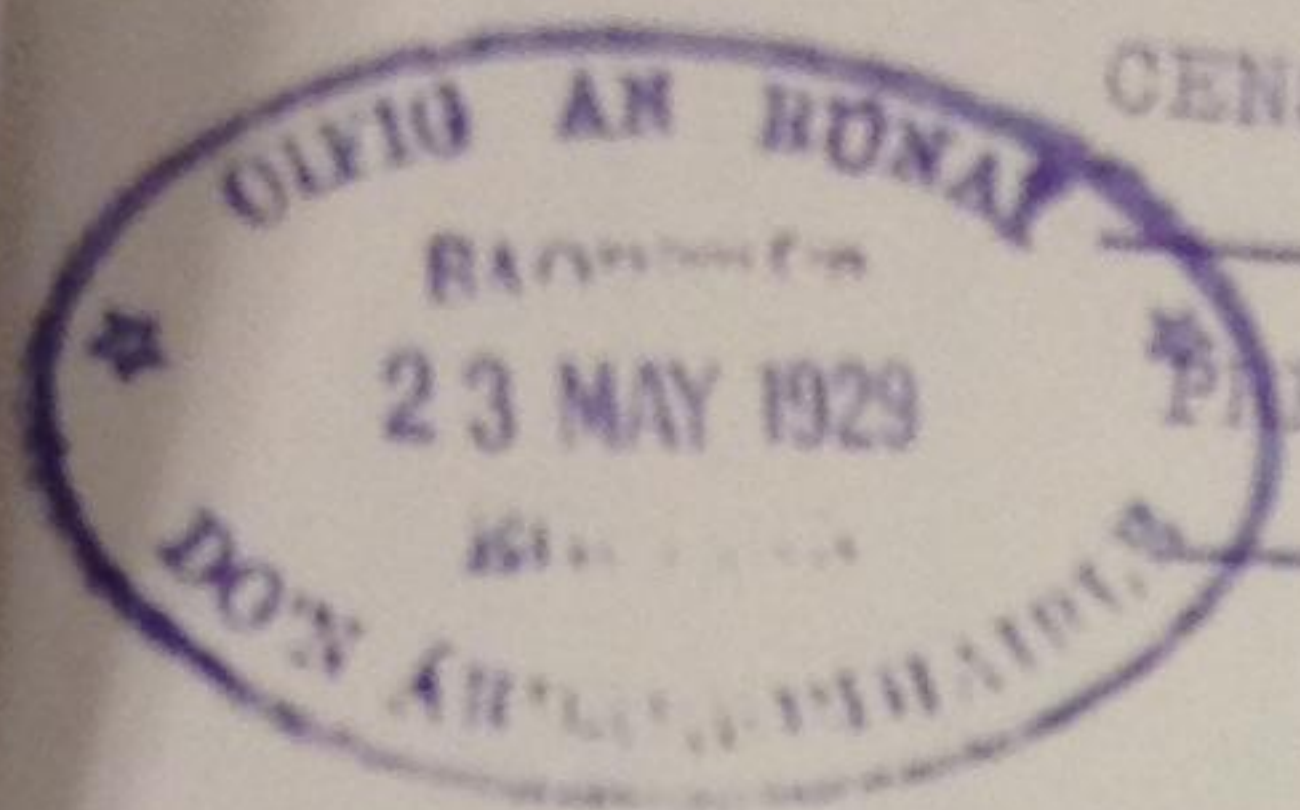

This Number ends the series of Preliminary Reports which have been issued in connection with the Census of Production 1926. A General Report will be published later in printed form containing the final figures together with a short analysis.

Reports have been compiled in respect of 35 Industries, Industry Groups or Services, and there remain unaccounted for a few Industries such as the manufacture of Sugar, Matches, Methylated Spirits, Carpets, Quilts, Starch, Religious Objects, Combs, Ice, Wool Flock, Fish Curing, Seed Crushing, Fellmongery and Tanning and Ship and Boat-building.

The more important of these Industries were in each case carried on by only one or two concerns and, as the Returns were obtained under the Statistics Act, which precludes the publication of any information in such a way as to disclose the business of any individual or firm, details of their Output cannot be published. The remaining Industries though important were carried on on too small a scale to warrant separate Reports.
