The above man's daughter was sent to High Park Convent by Judge Davitt for seven days expiring tomorrow, [Wednesday, and Miss Carroll, the Probation Officer was to report as to the possibilities of securing another place for this girl pending the trial of her father. Miss Carroll has now gone to London on urgent, personal business and will be unable to appear, but she has reported to me that she has not been able to secure any other refuge for this girl and states that the High Park Nuns are willing to keep the girl until the end of November of this year and, in the circumstances, she recommends that the necessary order be made by the Judge for this purpose.

Will you please take the matter up with the Judge tomorrow?
