### Recent Irish Wills

Mr. Joseph Edward Mills, late of Fir-  
mount, Kildare, County Dublin, who died  
on 3rd November, 1936, left in his Irish  
Free State £30,512. He provided for his  
widow, to whom he also left a  
household of £300 and the use of a residence  
at Wilton avenue, Sandycove, for her life,  
and also all articles of personal, domestic or  
household use belonging to himself or any  
other house in which he might reside. He  
also made provision for his son, two daughters  
and a granddaughter.

Mrs. Mary FitzGibbon, late of 53 Finghlin  
road, Dublin who died on 11th May, 1937,  
left in the Irish Free State £15,010.  
Requests include—To the Holy Trinity  
Charity, £2,000; Superiors, Sisters of  
Charity, Clonsilla, £500; Parish Priest, SS.  
Peter and Paul, Clonsilla, £200 for decoration  
or improvement of the church; Incurable  
Hospital, Cork, which is under the care of  
the Sisters of Charity, £100 for the founda-  
tion of two beds, to be called "The Mary  
FitzGibbon Beds"; Superiors, Hospice for  
the Dying, Harold's Cross, Dublin, £200;  
Superiors, Sacred Heart Home, Drum-  
condra, £500; Night Refuge for Men, Back-  
lane, Dublin, £200; Superiors, Magdalen  
Asylum, Donnybrook, £300; Superiors,  
Little Sisters of the Assumption, Camden  
street, Dublin, £200; Donnybrook Con-  
ference, St. Vincent, de Paul Society £200;  
Royal Hospital for Incurables, Donnybrook,  
£1,000 for the foundation of a bed,  
to be called the "Mary FitzGibbon  
Bed"; St. Joseph's Young Friends Society,  
£200 for the foundation of a house;  
the Abbot, Mount St. Joseph's, Roscrea,  
£200 to form a fund for the education of 12  
males yearly in perpetuity for the souls of  
herself, her relatives and friends; £200 to be  
applied by her trustees in having Gregorian  
Masses celebrated immediately after her  
death for the repose of her soul and in having  
Masses celebrated in Ireland for herself, her  
relatives and friends; the Parish Priest of  
Donnybrook, £500, to be applied in reduction  
of the debt for addition to and improvement  
of Donnybrook Parish Church; Superiors,  
Night Refuge, Cork street, £500.

Mr. Anthony Ryan, singer, late of Forster  
House, Galway and Shop street, Galway,  
who died on November 16, 1936, and left in  
the Irish Free State £20,740, bequeathed all  
his property to his widow.

Mrs. Jane Emily Trappett, widow, late of  
Deansie place, Donagh, who died on July  
26, 1936 left in the Irish Free State £8,300.  
She left £15 to her maid, Rose Hearty, if  
in her employment at the time of her death,  
and, after making another bequest, left the  
residue to her son, Henry G. Trappett.

Mr. John Francis Egan, pharmaceutical  
chemist, late of 33 South Earl street, Dublin,  
who died on February 14, 1937, left in the  
Irish Free State £4,372. He bequeathed all  
his property to his sisters, Mrs. Rose O'Leary  
and Mrs. Christina Wilson.

stewart, Co. Londonderry, who died on May  
17th last, left personal estate in Great Britain  
and Northern Ireland valued at £7,463.
