NOTICE OF CHARITABLE BEQUESTS

In the Goods of  
MARY GILL, Deceased, late of 27  
Mountjoy Square in the City of  
Dublin, Widow.

NOTICE IS HEREBY given pursuant to  
the Statute 30 and 31 Vic., Cap. 54, that  
the said Mary Gill by her Will dated the  
2nd June, 1933, bequeathed the following

and to be expended for the same object,  
£200 in the Church at Clarendon Street,  
Dublin, £100 in Saint Francis Xavier's  
Church, Upper Gardiner Street, Dublin, and  
£50 at Mount Argus, Harold's Cross,  
Dublin.

To the Blind Asylum, Merrion, £100.  
To the Magdalen Asylum, Gloucester  
Street, Dublin, £100.

To the Hospice for the Dying at Harold's  
Cross, Dublin, £200.

Testatrix also Gave, Devised and  
Bequeathed all her real and personal estate  
not thereby otherwise disposed of to her  
Executors Upon Trust to pay the proceeds  
to the Commissioners of Charitable Dona-  
tions and Bequests for Ireland to be held  
by them Upon Trust to pay the income  
thereof to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul  
in Dublin for the benefit of the Poor of  
Dublin visited by them, and she authorised  
the said Commissioners in their absolute  
discretion to cease paying the income of the  
said residue to the said Society of St.  
Vincent de Paul and to apply such income  
for the benefit of the Poor in Dublin  
through any other channel.

The said Deceased died on the 13th day  
of July, 1953, and Probate of her Will and  
one Codicil thereto (dated respectively 2nd  
June, 1933, and 9th March, 1946) was on  
the 13th November, 1953, granted forth of  
the Principal Probate Registry of the High  
Court of Justice to Harold Holmes Maxwell,  
Solicitor, 15 Eden Quay, Dublin, and  
William I. Miller, 3 Trinity Street, Dublin,  
the Executors named in the said Codicil.
