To the Very Reverend the Provincial for the time being of the Congregation of the Holy Ghost in Ireland the sum of Fifty Pounds upon trust for the charitable purposes of the Catholic Missions in Africa confided to the Irish Provinces of the Holy Ghost fathers.

Subject to the foregoing and to certain pecuniary bequests, the testatrix gave and bequeathed all the residue of her property to the following institutions in equal shares, viz:—

The Children's Hospital, Temple street, Dublin.

The Magdalen Asylum, Lower Gloucester street, Dublin.

The Hospice for the Dying, Harold's Cross, Dublin.

St. Patrick's House, 47 South Circular road, Kilmainham, Dublin.

The Little Sisters of the Assumption, 1 Upper Camden street, Dublin.

The Charitable Society of St. Vincent de Paul, to be applied for the purposes of the Free Night Shelter for Catholic men, at Back lane, Dublin.

The Morning Star Hostel, North Brunswick street, Dublin.

The St. Joseph's Night Refuge for Homeless Women and Children, Bialkfield, Dublin.

Probate of the said will was on the 14th May, 1942, granted forth of the Principal Registry, High Court of Justice, Eire, to James Plunkett, of 38 South Circular road, Kilmainham, Dublin, Esquire, one of the executors named in the said will.
