**NOTICE OF CHARITABLE BEQUESTS.**

**THOMAS DELAMERE ROONEY** (otherwise Thomas Rooney), Deceased.

Notice is hereby given that Thomas Delamere Rooney, (otherwise Thomas Rooney), late of 44 Upper O'Connell street, in the City of Dublin, Mercantile Clerk, by his Will dated the 3rd day of June, 1924, later alia made the following bequests:-

- To the St. Vincent de Paul Free Night Shelter for Catholic Men, Back lane, Dublin, the sum of One Hundred Pounds, to be applied for the charitable purposes of the Institution..... £100

And, after other bequests, the Testator bequeathed the residue of his property for such charitable purposes as his Executors might select. And the said Testator appointed Patrick Joseph Corcoran, of Athy, in the County of Kildare, Auctioneer, and Patrick Treacy, of Roske, Maynooth, in the County of Kildare, Farmer, to be the Executors of his said Will. The said Testator, Thomas Delamere Rooney (otherwise Thomas Rooney) died on the 4th day of November, 1926, and his said Will was proved by the said Patrick Joseph Corcoran and Patrick Treacy, and Probate thereof granted to them forth of the Principal Probate Registry of the High Court of Justice, Saorstad Eireann, on the 31st day of February, 1928.
