NOTICE OF CHARITABLE BEQUESTS. IN THE GOODS OF

MARTHA BLAKE, late of 20 Aughrim street,
in the City of Dublin, Spinster, Deceased.

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to the Statute
30 and 31 Vic. Cap 54, Section 19, that the
above-named Deceased who died on the 24th day
of December, 1937 by her Will, dated the 25th
day of October, 1937, bequeathed the following
legacies, that is to say:—

(1) Three-eighths of the residue of her estate
when ascertained to be expended in having Masses
said for the repose of her soul at an honorarium
of Five shillings per Mass.

(2) One-eighth of the residue to be divided
in having Masses said for the souls of her deceased
parents, relatives and for the Poor Souls in
Purgatory who have no one to pray for them in
equal shares.

(3) Two-eighths of the residue shall be paid
to the Superior for the time being of the Capuchin
Fathers, Church street, Dublin.

(4) One-eighth of the residue to be paid to the
Superiores for the time being of the Magdalen
Asylum, Gloucester street, Dublin.

(5) One-eighth of the residue to the Society
of the Holy Childhood per Sister Celestine, Stan-
hope street Convent, Dublin, who will disburse
this sum according to her wishes.

Probate of the said Will was, on the 19th
day of February, 1938, granted to Roger Greene,
of 11 Wellington quay, Dublin, the sole executor
in the said Will named forth of the Principal
Probate Registry, High Court of Justice in Ire-
land.
