NOTICE OF CHARITABLE BEQUESTS

In the Goods of
**LAURENCE WILLIAM RAYMOND
MURPHY**, late of 17 Clarinda
park, Dun Laoghaire, in the
County of Dublin, High Court
Registrar (Retired).

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant
to the Charities Act, 1961, that the
above named Deceased, who died on
the 24th July, 1961, by his Will dated
3rd January, 1956, and one Codicil
dated 23rd February, 1959, bequeathed:

1. His clothing, footwear and bed-
ding to the Wardrobe Committee of
the Society of St. Vincent de Paul,
Ozanam House, Dublin, for the Poor.

2. All other property of every nature
and kind which he was possessed of
or entitled to at the time of his death
to his Executors and Trustees upon
certain trusts and ultimately upon
trust to pay inter alia as follows:
£100 to the Holy Ghost Fathers, Black-
rock College, County Dublin; £50 to
the Franciscan Fathers, Merchant's
quay, Dublin; £50 to the Sacred
Heart Home, Drumcondra; £50 to
the Magdalen Asylum, Gloucester
street, Dublin; £50 to the Magdalen
Asylum, High park, Drumcondra; £50
to the Magdalen Asylum, Donny-
brook; £50 to the National Council
for the Blind of Ireland, 11 Molesworth
street, Dublin; half of the then re-
mainder of his Estate to the Father
Provincial of the Society of Jesus,
Upper Gardiner street, Dublin, for
any purposes of the Society in Ireland
or abroad, and the remaining half to
the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, 64
Grafton street, Dublin, for the purpose
of the Society in the Diocese of
Dublin and he directed that out of this
bequest, £200 be allocated to St. Vin-
cent's Orphanage, Glasnevin, and £100
to the Society's Night Shelter for Men
at Backlane, Dublin.

Probate of the said Will and Codicil
was on the 18th day of May, 1962,
granted to the Governor and Company
of the Bank of Ireland having its
registered office at College green,
Dublin, the sole Executor.
