NOTICE OF CHARITABLE BEQUESTS.

In the Goods of

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to 30 and 31
Victoria, Cap. 54, that the above-named Anna
Kane, made, inter alia, the following bequests,
viz.:—£200 to the Hospice for the Dying, Harold's
Cross, Dublin; £200 to the Convent of the Good
Shepherd, Limerick; £200 to the Mandalen Asylum,
Donnybrook, County Dublin; £100 to the Sick and
Indigent Roomkeepers Society, Dublin; £200 to
the Sacred Heart Home, Drumcondra, County
Dublin; £200 to the Blind Asylum, Merrion, County
Dublin; £200 to the Deaf and Dumb Institution,
Cabra, County Dublin; £200 to the Society of the
Distressed Irish Ladies' Home, 28 Mountjoy square,
Dublin; £200 to the St. Vincent de Paul Society,
Dublin, the foregoing bequests being for the
charitable objects of such institutions; £100 to
the Superior of the Carmelites, Whitefriar street,
Dublin, for Masses to be said in Public and in the
Free State, for the Repose of the Souls of her
parents, brothers, sisters and herself; £100 to
the Mother, Abbess, Franciscan Convent, Drum-
shambo, County Leitrim, in aid of the Perpetual
Adoration; and, subject to certain annuities in
said Will mentioned, Testatrix directed her Trustees
to divide the rents and profits of her Limerick prop-
erty, so long as such annuities were payable,
equally between the Superiors of the Good
Shepherd, Limerick, and the Superiors of the
Convent of Mercy, Limerick, and the Society of
St. Vincent de Paul, in the City of Limerick, for
the charitable objects of said respective institutions,
carried on by them in the Free State. Testatrix
bequeathed the apportionment of rents out of said
property in Limerick to the time of her death,
subject to the apportionment of outgoing payable
thereout, to the Convent of the Good Shepherd,
Limerick, the Convent of Mercy, Limerick, and the
Society of St. Vincent de Paul, in the City of
Limerick, share and share alike for the charitable
objects carried on by them. After the determina-
tion of said annuities, Testatrix directed her
Trustees to sell said property, and, in payment
of certain legacies, Testatrix left said property
and the proceeds thereof equally between the
Convent of the Good Shepherd, Limerick, the
Convent of Mercy, Limerick, and the Presentation
Convent, Limerick, for the charitable objects of
such institutions; and Testatrix gave and be-
queathed the residue of her property equally be-
tween the Mandalen Asylum, Donnybrook, Dublin,
the Sacred Heart Home, Drumcondra, Dublin, and
the Hospital for Children, Temple street, Dublin,
for the charitable objects of said respective in-
stitutions. Said Testatrix died on the 7th day
of October, 1927, and Probate of said Will was
on the 9th day of December, 1927, granted by
the High Court of Justice (Probate), Saorstad
Éireann, to Sir George Roche, of 20 St. Stephen's
Green, N., Dublin, the sole Executor therein named.
